Rationale

There is an expectation at St Peter's College that there is an acceptable style of hair and grooming for all boys.

Purposes

The purpose of this Policy is to detail expectations about St Peter's College with regard to hair and grooming.

Guidelines

- a) Hair must be a student's natural colour.
- b) Hair must not be below the collar, longer hair can be dangerous in practical classes and students will have to tie hair up if requested.
- c) Hair must be tied back if eyes and face are not visible.
- d) Extreme hair styles are not permitted. These include, but are not limited to dreadlocks, mohawks, shaved lines or any such styles that are studied efforts to draw attention to the student.
- e) All students must be clean shaven.
