



ST PETERS BASKETBALL PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

At St Peters we have students from year 7 through to 13 and playing at various levels ie Participation/Social to Competitive.

In 2011 we had 82 students playing basketball and in 2018 we had 370 players.

St Peters College has a strong basketball programme with teams competing at the Premiere, Open, Under-17, Under-15 and Middle School levels. We also have a Social League, which is an in-house basketball league, for beginners and social players.

Our gymnasium has a main court with two small basketball courts that run across the main court which we use for training and competition. The school itself has several outdoor hoops.

Our 2019 programme major goals are:

- 1st V to retain status in the premier grade and qualify for the National Secondary Schools Tournament
- U17A qualify for Greater Auckland Tournament
- Junior Premiership team to make top 10
- Middle School team to make Top 15 at AIMS and qualify for the Inter-zone Tournament.

Recent Basketball Programme Achievements

2018

1st V placed 7th in the College Sport Auckland Premiere Grade, Junior Prems placed 7th at the Zone 1 regional tournament and AIMS team placed 26th.

2018 also saw the inauguration of the St Peters Social League.

2017

We were the Auckland Senior A Grade (1st V) and Middle School Central Zone champions. Our 1st V qualified for the National Tournament for the first time in the school's history and also qualified to compete in the 2018 College Sport Auckland Premier Grade.

2016

We were the Auckland Greater Wider Basketball Open Grade (1st V) and U15 Central Zone champions, Runners up in the U17 Central zone and Middle School Central Zone tournament.

We have also had many St Peters College basketball players go on to regional representative honours.

Playing Uniform – Social Teams

Teams are to get their own uniforms and these are to be organised by the team.

T-shirts or singlets only. These are to be all the same colour and must have at least one number on them (from 0 – 99 only). The number can either be on the front or back of the T-shirt/singlet. Second number is optional and not required.

Shorts do not have to be uniform but must be worn (no track pants to be worn).
