

St Peter's College Snowsports -2019



St Peter's is ready and looking forward to the upcoming season. We want to gauge the interest in boys who wish to enter the North Island Skiing and Snowboarding Championships to be held at Mt Ruapehu in August/September.

All ability levels are welcome, skiers/snowboarders do not need to have racing experience and skill to attend the training. The teams will be selected later in the term.

This year we will continue our Thursday training sessions at Snowplanet Silverdale, this session is shared with St Marys. Last year many boys improved their skills and times after attending this training.

St Peter's College has had more students participating in Skiing than snowboard. However, we are very keen to have Snowboarders join the SPC Snow sports team. Snowboarders can join the Ski team training sessions, however if there is a minimum of 6 to train they can have their own coach. They could also do this with non SPC kids, and at a time they arranged. We will confirm if we have a specialist coach once registrations are in.

Training details are:

- Venue:** Snowplanet – Silverdale
Dates: Term 2: Thursdays from 2nd May and run every Thursday until races in Term 3.
Time: 5 pm for 5.30 - 7.00 pm session.
Costs: \$56 per session for non Snowplanet members. \$44 for members. Includes Entry and Coaching. Gear hireage is additional - \$22 per week. Helmets are compulsory for training - \$5 per week. This is to be paid on the day at Snowplanet. (**please note these prices are based on previous years, so may be subject to change*)

Transport: A school van will be available to transport students to and from Snowplanet, parent assistance will be required to drive the van

Selection for Champs

Team selections will be based on time trials in term 3. Ideally, we would like 1 senior team of 5 skiers, 1 junior team of 5 skiers. However, this will be dependent on the number of skiers that register.
