Training

Training starts on Monday, 4th May from 6:15pm till 8pm (TBC) at Diocesan School for Girls, Clyde St, Epsom.

Boys are to wear *speedos* (not shorts) at training and their SPC Sports gear.

At each training session a roll will be taken, boys are given a water polo rules session, 10 min land warm up and are in the water from 6.30pm till 8pm.

Season/Games

The intermediate season is a long one, with the competition running throughout term 2 and 3. The teams will be entered in the Central competition which is played at EGGS, starting in early Term 2.

Fees

Fees will be set once the number of players is confirmed. We anticipate the fees to be between \$275 - \$350 for the season which includes, pool hire, coaching and competition entry. Once teams have been confirmed the fee will be added to your son's portal.

Players will need to purchase a pair of SPC speedos prior to the competition games starting. These cost approx.. \$59 and can be purchased from the Edmund Rice Shop.
