Yr 9 and 10 JUNIOR WATER POLO INFORMATION



Welcome to St Peter's Junior (Yr 9 and 10) Water polo programme for 2020. The Junior Water polo season is a short season with the squad training throughout Term 3 as a lead up to the competition which takes place in Term 4.

Training

- Trainings will start on Monday 20th July 7.45pm – 9.30pm* at Diocesan School, Clyde St, Epsom (In term 4 trainings with move to the 6.15pm – 8.30pm* timeslot (*times TBC))
- Monday trainings will go through terms 3 and 4 (finishing in late November when competitions finish).
- We will be looking to organise a second training time in late term 3 and term 4. However, this is subject to pool availability.
- Boys are to wear speedos (not shorts) at training and their SPC sports gear

Teams

- Teams will be selected mid Term 3; the number of teams will be determined by the number of registered players.
- Please note registrations are open to Year 9 and 10 students only in the first instance. Registrations will then be opened to Year 7 and 8 students only if numbers are required to make up team numbers.

Competitions

- Teams will play in the College Sport Auckland Water polo competition, which commences on the 16th October. Games are held on Fridays afternoons and/or Sunday evenings in various pools around Auckland. Boys are required to wear SPC swim togs, these can be purchased from the Edmunds Shop.

Tournaments:

- Taupo Tournament, Labour Weekend
- North Island Junior Champs, Auckland – 28th Nov – 1st Dec, Auckland Pools

Fees:

- Fees will be set once the number of players is confirmed, they will be between \$280 - \$320 which includes the pool hire, coaching fees and College Sport entry fee. Entry to the tournaments is additional.
