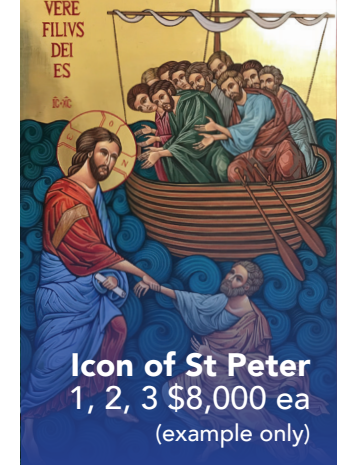

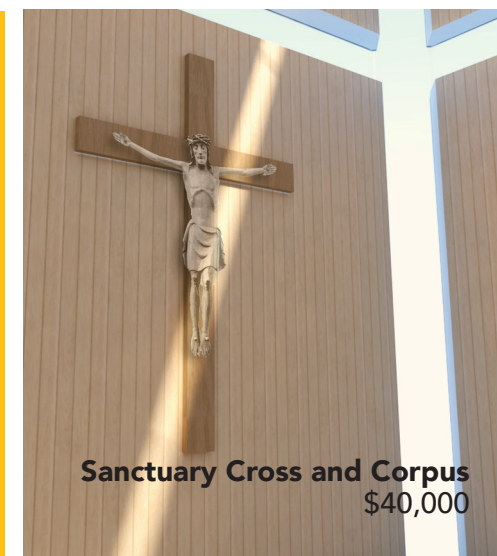
## THE CHAPEL JOURNEY

In our eightieth Jubilee year, it is fitting that we are constructing a new St Peter's College Chapel to provide a permanent space for the school community to celebrate our faith.

Situated in the centre of the school grounds and overlooking Khyber Pass, the new chapel will be a symbol of our faith both to our students and to the wider Auckland community.

From the early days of St Peter's history, a college chapel has been a vital space to pray, reflect, and celebrate the Sacraments. The Christian Brothers originally maintained a chapel in their accommodation quarters onsite, before a small chapel was built adjacent to the administration block in 1953. The college soon outgrew this space, after which followed numerous temporary chapels in what were normally classroom spaces.

Over the past decade the community has exclusively raised the funds necessary to finally provide a chapel we can be proud of and that will serve the needs of future generations of St Peter's College men.
