March 23, 2.30pm:

Dear Parents

The Government has made the decision for the nation to enter into full lockdown from Thursday for a minimum of 4 weeks.

St Peter's College will be closed from tomorrow until Term 2.

Can I reassure you that our staff will ensure that your son's lessons will continue, albeit differently. All boys are to be working from home as if it was a normal school day and following their usual timetable. This will mean boys will need to follow the same routine as school, with the same classes, breaks and the same end of the day. It will not be perfect and there will be some teething issues, however, our staff have prepared for this time and are ready.

A small team of staff will be onsite on Tuesday and Wednesday to cater for any boys of essential workers who require supervision.
