

Announcements from the Headmaster:

April 20, 6.15pm:

Dear Parents,

Following the Governments announcement today the nation will move out of Level 4 Lockdown to Alert Level 3 next Monday 27th April at 11.59pm.

Level 3 allows schools to open for students up to Year 10. However, the Government is asking all students that can remain at home do so, and continue with distance learning.

At St Peter's Year 7 to Year 13 will continue with online learning until the nation moves to Alert Level 2.

We appreciate that there will some families that will be returning to work and will need to have their sons at school. Therefore St Peter's will be open for supervision of students in Year 7 to Year 10 from 8.30am on Wednesday 29th April.

Boys will be supervised by staff and will continue with their online lessons with their classmates. There will be no face to face teaching during Level 3 as all our staff will be continuing with their online classes. Boys will follow their same timetable and will break for interval and lunch. The tuck shop will not be open and the school day will conclude at 2.50pm. All physical distancing and hygiene measures will be met.

If you are needing to send your son into school from next Wednesday 29th April, and for the remainder of Alert Level 3, then I ask that you please email the following staff by 9am Wednesday 22nd April.

This will enable us to ensure we have the correct ratio of staff onsite.

The Government has said that they will inform the nation of when we will move to Alert Level 2 on Monday 11th May. At this time we will know when we can cease online learning and return all our boys and staff to Mountain Rd.

I must reiterate that if you can keep your Y7- Y10 son at home to continue his learning then that is the best option for him. If you cannot, then please send him to school knowing he will be looked after.
