

NCEA and Cambridge Senior Mid-Year Exams – Week 9 – 15th -19th June 2020

Dear Student and Parents,

The NCEA and CIEA senior mid-year examinations are being held during week 9, from Monday 15th June until Friday 19th June.

There are 2 sessions of exams per day - mainly held in the Hall - but other sessions are in alternate spaces. Please check the timetable carefully for specific exam locations.

The morning session starts at 8.30am promptly. You are expected to be at the Hall by 8.10am at the latest.

The afternoon session starts at 12.30pm promptly and you are expected at the Hall at 12.10pm.

There is study leave all week for Years 11-13 students. You are welcome to prepare for examinations in the school library or any other designated room. However, this facility is for study only. Please be mindful of the school day running as normal for Years 7-10.

Any examinations that are not taking place in the Hall will follow the same process in terms of starting times. Please read your timetable carefully, and, if in doubt, check with your teacher.

Please check for any exam clashes – if you have any please see Mr Kalinowski before Wednesday 10th June (week 8) to arrange an alternative session.

STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

Attendance is compulsory unless a medical certificate is provided for the day of the examination.

Full school uniform is a pre-requisite of attendance at any exam

Students are to check with respective teachers with regard to additional materials for the exam such as calculators. I provide all exam lined and plain refill paper.

Students are to bring stationery in a **clear plastic bag**

Students should avoid bringing objects of personal value, mobiles, iPods etc.

Students have had their attention drawn to the rules that NZQA, Cambridge International and St Peter's have. Please ensure that they are followed without exception in the examination rooms.
