Year 9 and 10 End of Year Examinations 11th to 17th November 2020

Dear Student and Parents,

The Year 9 and 10 end of year examinations are being held during week 5 and 6, from Wednesday 11th November to Tuesday 17th November.

There are 2 sessions of exams per day - mainly held in the Hall and O Block - but other sessions are in alternate spaces. Please check the timetable carefully for specific exam locations.

Students are to go to the yard assembly each day. Following this they will attend period 1 in an assigned room.

The morning session starts at 10.00am promptly. You are expected to be at the exam venue by 9.40am at the latest.

The afternoon sessions on Monday, Thursday and Friday starts at 1.00pm promptly and you are expected at the exam venue at 12.40pm.

The afternoon sessions on Wednesday starts at 1.10pm promptly and you are expected at the exam venue at 12.50pm.

There is no study leave all week for Years 9 and 10 students. Students will be onsite at all times.

Students are advised that in the time period between examinations the school is in session as normal for Years 7-8 and that this is respected fully.

Any examinations that are not taking place in the Hall will follow the same process in terms of starting times. Please read your timetable carefully, and, if in doubt, check with your teacher.

There are no toilet breaks during the exams. Students are to be prepared for this in the 30 minutes before the examination begins.

STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

Attendance is compulsory unless a medical certificate is provided for the day of the examination.

Full school uniform is a pre-requisite of attendance at any exam

Students are to check with respective teachers regarding additional materials for the exam such as calculators.

Students are to bring stationery in a **clear plastic bag.**

Students should avoid bringing objects of personal value, mobiles, iPods etc.

Students have had their attention drawn to the examination rules that St Peter's has in place. Please ensure that they are followed without exception in the examination rooms.
