Teams

For the 2021 season, St Peter's College will again be fielding a large number of teams in grades appropriate to the boy's ability and age.

Uniform

All teams are required to wear the St Peter's Football Shirt. They are short sleeve and available from the Edmunds Shop for \$85.00.

Fees

Fees are \$40 for the season (except 1st XI)

Once trials have been completed and the teams are confirmed, the charge will be loaded onto the portal. Please pay by internet banking or via the portal. Please **do not** pay until your son has been confirmed in a team.

Registration Forms

Registration forms can be completed online (preferred) or a hard copy can be obtained from the sports office. Forms are to be returned to the sports office by **Monday 8th March**.

Trials at the SPC Cage:

13th Grade – year 9: Sunday 14th March 9am-10am (trial for 13A)

14th /15th Grade – year 10: Sunday 14th March 10am-11.15am (trials for 14A/15A)

We advise all players to attend their age group trials if they want to trial for the A teams.

(1st and 2nd XI are selected from Senior Academy)

Boys that do not make the age group A teams:

Year 12 and 13 players:

All players who do not make the 1st or 2nd XI squads will be placed into coloured teams. I.e Blue/Yellow/Gold etc

There will be a meeting in the Gym late March for all players wishing to be put into a coloured team, or to enter social teams with friends. Date will be announced at Yard Assembly.

Year 9, 10 and 11 players:

All players who do not make the 13A, 14A, or 15A teams will be placed in coloured teams. I.e Blue/Yellow/Gold etc

There will be a meeting in the Gym late March for all players wishing to be put into a coloured team. Date will be announced at Yard Assembly.

Game Times

Senior grades and 15th Grade play at 10.00am.

13th and 14th grade play at 9.00am.

Two co-curricular activities

The schools expectation is that your son engages in two co-curricular activities. Ideally from a sports perspective this is a winter sport and a summer sport.

We do not recommend your son registers for two core winter sports. The core winter sports are Rugby, Football, Basketball and Hockey. The main reason for this is to avoid training clashes. If you require further details/clarification contact Nicky Cattermoul, Director of Sport.
