All ability levels are welcome, skiers/snowboarders do not need to have racing experience and skill to attend the sessions. The teams will be selected later in the year. Pupils can attend training after school on Thursdays. Previously pupils have preferred free-ski sessions. If pupils require coaching, there is a minimum number of pupils required for a group session. Alternatively, pupils can book lessons directly with Snowplanet.

Historically St Peter's College has had more pupils participating in Skiing than snowboarding. We are very keen to have Snowboarders join the SPC Snow sports team. Snowboarders can join the Ski team for training sessions.

Training details are:

Venue: Snowplanet – Silverdale

Dates: Term 2: Thursdays from 22nd of May, last training: 19th of June.

Term 3: Thursdays from 17th July, last training: 21st August.

Time: 5 pm for 2 hour night session.

Costs: Night pass 2 hours \$42 from Snowplanet website. Gear hireage is additional. Helmets

are compulsory. Fees to be paid on the day to Snowplanet.

Transport: A school mini-van will be available to transport pupils to and from Snowplanet, parent assistance will be required to drive the mini-van.
